<p>What is the overall deductible?</p>	<p>For in-network providers: \$2,500/individual or \$5,000/family For out-of-network providers: \$4,500/individual or \$9,000/family Combined medical/behavioral and pharmacy deductible Deductible per individual applies when the employee is the only individual covered under the plan.</p>	<p>Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the policy, the overall family deductible must be met before the plan begins to pay.</p>
<p>Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?</p>	<p>Yes. In-network preventive care & immunizations are covered before you meet your deductible.</p>	<p>This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. <p>What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?</p>	<p>For in-network providers \$4,500/individual or \$6,850/family For out-of-network providers \$9,000/individual or \$13,700/family Combined medical/behavioral and pharmacy out-of-pocket</p>	<p>The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan, the overall family out-of-pocket limit must be met.</p>
<p>What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?</p>	<p>Penalties for failure to obtain pre-authorization for services, premiums, balance-billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.</p>	<p>Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.</p>
<p>Will you pay less if you use a network provider?</p>	<p>Yes. See www.cigna.com or call 1-800-Cigna24 for a list of network providers.</p>	<p>This plan uses a provider network. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network. You will pay the most if you use an out-of-network provider, and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your plan pays (balance billing). Be aware your network provider might use an out-of-network provider for some services (such as lab work). Check with your provider before you get services.</p>

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes

About these Coverage Examples:



This is not a cost estimator. Treatments shown are just examples of how this [plan](#) might cover medical care. Peg is Having a Baby
(9 months of in-network pre-natal care and a hospital delivery)
